UPCOMING: Rensselaer returns to the Houston Field House next weekend to kick-off a four-game homestand ... The Engineers host North Country-rivals St. Lawrence and Clarkson on Friday (7pm) and Saturday (7pm), respectively, and Cornell and Colgate on February 3-4.

TICKETS: Tickets to all Rensselaer home games are available through the Houston Field House box office or by calling 518-276-6262.

RENSSELAER TO DATE: Rensselaer averages 1.50 goals on 26.2 shots per game with 14.8 penalty minutes per contest ... The Engineers allow 3.14 goals and 27.3 shots per game ... The opposition averages 13.5 PIMs.

OFFENSIVE LEADERS: Junior Nick Bailyen (4 goals, 10 assists), a defenseman, is RPI's leading scorer with 14 points ... Sophomore Brock Higgs (1 goal, 11 assists), a forward, is second with 12, followed by freshman forward Ryan Haggerty (team-high 5 goals, 4 assists) ... Bailyen has played all 22 games, while Higgs and Haggerty have suited up for 17 and 19, respectively.

IN GOAL: Junior Bryce Merriam and freshman Scott Diebold have been sharing time in net lately, alternating starts over the last 10 games ... On the season Merriam is 3-12-0

with a 2.66 goals against average and an .901 save percentage ... Diebold is 1-5-1 with a 2.85 average and a .899 percentage ... Merriam and Diebold have one shutout each.

SPECIAL TEAMS: The Engineers are 12 for 101 (11.9%) on the power play ... RPI is 96 for 114 (84.2%) when shorthanded with one goal for (Alex Angers-Goulet).

RPI LAST TIME OUT: The Engineers played just one game last weekend, falling at #14 Union, 5-1 ... The Dutchmen scored two power play goals and two shorthanded goals in defeating RPI, which got a shorthanded goal from junior defenseman Nick Bailyen ... Freshman Scott Diebold made 35 saves for Rensselaer ... Troy Grosenick, a sophomore, stopped 39 shots for the Dutchmen.

SCORING CHANGE: RPI's goal at Union last week was originally credited to Brock Higgs with assists going to Nick Bailyen and Mark McGowan ... Upon further review, it is Bailyen who gets credit with the goal with assists to Higgs and McGowan.

TEAM HIGHS: Rensselaer's 40 shots against Union last Saturday night marked a season high for the Engineers ... The 40 shots allowed to the Dutchmen was also a season high.

INDIVIDUALLY: Freshmen Ryan Haggerty and Scott Diebold both recorded individual game highs at Union ... Haggerty had eight

POINT STREAKS: Junior defenseman **Nick Bailen** (1 goal, 5 assists) is riding a five-game point streak ... Sophomore **Brock Higgs** has a point in seven of his last eight games, tallying a goal and seven assists in that span ... He has a goal and nine helpers in eight of his last 10 games.

STREAK SNAPPED: Junior forward **Marty O'Grady** (4 assists) had a four-game assist streak broken at Union.

WITHOUT GOULET: Senior forward **Alex Angers-Goulet** has missed the last two games due to a leg injury ... His status for this weekend is unknown.

RPI LAST TUESDAY NIGHT: Junior **C.J. Lee** had a goal and an assist, **Curtis Leonard** scored his first career goal and **Joel Malchuk** tallied an empty net goal as the Engineers defeated American International in their final non-league game of the regular season ... RPI held a 2-0 lead late in the third period before the Yellow Jackets pulled to within one at 17:03 ... Junior **Bryce Merriam** made 15 saves for Rensselaer, which outshot AIC, 37-16 ... Ben Meisner made 34 saves in defeat.

SEASON LOW: The 16 shots allowed by RPI on Tuesday tied the fewest given up in a game this season ... The Engineers also held Army to 16 shots on goal (Dec. 30).

FIRST EMPTY NET GOAL: Rensselaer scored its first empty net goal of the season on Tuesday night ... The Engineers have allowed 10 such goals, including one at Union on Saturday.

NON-LEAGUE COMPLETE: The Engineers finished 3-9-0 in non-conference regular season contests ... They were 1-3-0 against the WCHA, 0-3-0 versus the CCHA, 2-1-0 against Atlantic Hockey, 0-1-0 versus ECAC Hockey and 0-1-0 against Hockey East.

NON-LEAGUE LEADERS: Sophomore **Brock Higgs** had seven points (1 goal, 6 assists) in seven non-league games to lead the Engineers ... **Nick Bailen** (2 goals, 3 assists) had five points, while freshman **Ryan Haggerty** (2 goals, 2 assists) tallied four against non-conference opposition ... **Bryce Merriam** played eight games, going 2-6-0 with a 2.54 goals against average and .905 save percentage ... **Scott Diebold** is 1-3-0 with a 2.77 average and an .884 percentage.

OFFICIALS: The referees for Friday night are Mike Baker and Scott Wheeler ... The linesmen are Brett Reed and Todd Whittemore ... Saturday's officials are Baker and Scott Whittemore (referees) and Glen Cooke and Kenneth Gates (linesmen).

FIRST TIME AROUND: The Engineers split their previous games with the Bulldogs and the Bears, losing to Yale, 2-0, and defeating Brown, 1-0 ... Junior goaltender **Bryce Merriam** made 27 saves in the loss to the Bulldogs and 22 in the shutout of the Bears ... Freshman **Ryan Haggarty** scored the lone goal for RPI, which snapped an eight-game losing streak with the victory.

ALL-TIME VS THE BEARS: The Engineers are 54-22-6 in 81 games against Brown ... RPI's 54 wins is third most against any one opponent.

ROAD RECORD: RPI is 21-13-3 (.608) in 37 meetings all-time at Brown.

RECENTLY: Rensselaer has won the last three meetings with Brown and four of the last five.

LAST 11: The Engineers are 8-3-0 in the last 11 meetings with the Bears ... RPI's record improves to 12-3-1 in the last 16 meetings.

UNDER APPERT: RPI is 10-3-1 against Brown under head coach **Seth Appert**.

IN ECAC HOCKEY: The Engineers are 47-16-6 against the Bears in ECAC Hockey play ... Their 47 wins is most vs. any ECAC Hockey foe.

IN OVERTIME: Rensselaer holds a 4-3-6 advantage in 13 OT contests vs. Brown.

BLANKING THE BEARS: The Engineers have nine shutouts all-time against Brown,

which is the most in school history against any one opponent, tied with Army.

BROWN TO DATE: The Bears are paced offensively by senior Jack Maclellan (9 goals, 10 assists), who has 19 points ... He is followed by freshman Ryan Jacobson (8 goals, 7 assists) with 15 points ... Senior netminder Mike Clemente (6-7-1) has played 80.9% of his team's minutes this season, and carries a 2.43 goals against average and a .911 save percentage.

ALL-TIME VS YALE: Rensselaer has gone 52-40-6 against Yale ... The 98 games ranks fifth against any one opponent and the 52 wins are fourth most – two behind Friday's opponent, Brown.

ROAD RECORD: RPI is 21-22-3 (.489) in 46 meetings all-time at Yale .

RECENTLY: The Engineers have won three of their last five meetings with Yale, including a 5-2 over the Bulldogs, then the #1 team in the nation, last season.

LAST 11: RPI is 3-7-1 its last 11 meetings with the Bulldogs ... Seth Appert has a 4-8-1 coaching record against Yale.

IN LEAGUE PLAY: The Engineers are 46-30-4 against Yale in ECAC Hockey play ... The 80 games are fourth most against any ECAC Hockey foes ... The club's 46 wins are the most against league foe.

IN EXTRA TIME: Rensselaer is 7-4-4 all-time in overtime games against Yale.

YALE TO DATE: The Bulldogs are led offensively by senior Brian O'Neill (12 goals, 10 assists), who has 22 points ... Junior Andrew Miller (4 goals, 16 assists) is second with 20 points, while classmate Antoine Agostino (6 goals, 8 assists) has 16 ... Junior goaltender Jeff Malcolm, who has played 97.1% of the team's minutes in net, has a 2.63 average and a .914 save percentage.

AT BROWN & YALE: The Engineers have made the Brown and Yale roadtrip on 13 occasions and have come away with two of a possible four points eight times ... They have collected all four points on the other five trips.

SWEEPS: Rensselaer's last weekend sweep at Yale and Brown came in 2006-07 ... The Engineers also took both games in 1990-91, 1989-90, 1988-89 and 1984-85.

HEAD COACH SETH APPERT

Seth Appert is in his sixth season as the head coach of the men's hockey program, having led Rensselaer to a 69-98-23 record while consistently playing one of the toughest schedules in the nation since taking over in April of 2006.

Last season was Appert's most successful to date at Rensselaer, as the Engineers posted a 20-13-5 record, a national ranking for most of the season and the program's first trip to the NCAA Tournament since 1995. The team was 13-6-1 at the Houston Field House on its way to recording back-to-back winning seasons for the first time in nearly 10 years (2000-01 & 2001-02).

Individually, RPI had a number of student-athletes garner significant honors. Forward Chase Polacek earned ECAC Hockey Player of the Year, Hobey Baker Award finalist and National All-America – all for the second straight season. It is just the third time in the long history of ECAC Hockey that a player repeated as Player of the Year.

Defenseman Nick Bailen was also recognized with All-ECAC Hockey First Team as well as National All-American Second Team honors and goaltender Allen York was named to the league's Third Team.

At season's end, Appert signed a contract extension that will keep him in Troy through at least the 2017-18 season.

The 2009-10 campaign also featured a number of highlights as the Engineers finished with an 18-17-4 record, including a 10-9-3 mark in ECAC Hockey play. RPI earned home-ice advantage in the first round of the ECAC Hockey Playoffs for the first time since 2005-06. Polacek was one of 10 finalists for the prestigious Hobey Baker Award, while earning ECAC Hockey Player of the Year honors. Freshman Jerry D'Amigo was the league's Rookie of the Year and classmate Brandon Pirri joined him on the All-Rookie Team. York was a finalist for Goaltender of the Year in ECAC Hockey.

In 2008-09, Appert's Engineers swept Dartmouth in the ECAC Hockey Playoffs on their way to the quarterfinals, where they were eliminated in a decisive third game. The team's top four scorers were either freshmen or sophomores and one of those first-year players, Patrick Cullen, was named to ECAC Hockey's All-Rookie Team. Two of RPI's incoming recruits – Pirri and D'Amigo – were selected in the NHL Draft by Chicago and Toronto, respectively. They have since signed NHL contracts with those clubs.

Highlights during Appert's first two seasons include leading the Engineers to back-to-back titles in the Governor's Cup Tourna-



ment – Rensselaer's first championships of any kind since 1998 – and garnering points against six nationally-ranked opponents. RPI had a nationally-ranked recruiting classes and also enjoyed time in the national polls, including eight straight weeks in 2007-08.

Individually, Rensselaer student-athletes have earned All-League and All-Rookie status as well as having a Student-Athlete of the Year Award finalist and a Hockey Humanitarian Award finalist.

Specifically in Appert's first season, the Engineers captured the inaugural Governor's Cup Championship and won at nationally-ranked Denver – Appert's first career win, which came against his previous employer. Individually, senior defenseman Jake Luthi earned All-League, while classmate Kirk MacDonald, a forward, garnered the USCHO.com's Unsung Hero Award, as well as several national community service honors.

In 2007-08, Rensselaer's recruiting class was nationally-ranked, the Engineers captured the Governor's Cup, forward Andrew Lord was a finalist for the ECAC Hockey Scholar-Athlete Award and Polacek was selected to the ECAC Hockey All-Rookie Team.

In addition to his position at RPI, Appert has worked with USA Hockey in a number of capacities. He was an assistant coach for the 2007 U.S. Under-18 Select Team that competed in the Memorial of Ivan Hlinka Tournament and was the head coach in both 2008 and 2011. He was also a coach in the 2008 NCAA Pontiac Skills Challenge and was named president of the AHCA, which has almost 1,400 members, in May of 2008. Appert is currently the AHCA Past President.

"In just one year Seth has become an important member of the Rensselaer community with a very positive influence across the campus," said President Shirley Ann Jackson upon the announcement of Appert's first contract extension. "He has shown a willingness to meet challenges head on and a determination to succeed. These are attributes that will

continue to shape outstanding young men, while generating a great deal of excitement and increasing levels of success on the ice."

"Seth's ambition and enthusiasm fit perfectly for Rensselaer," said then-Vice President of Student Life Eddie Ade Knowles. "When looking at the outstanding young men he recruits, as well as the eagerness to play the best teams in the country, there is no doubt we will again become one of the nation's elite programs. I look forward to working with him for many years to come."

"I am very thankful to President Jackson and Dr. Knowles for their continued support of our program and the vision and leadership they provide for our university," said Appert. "We have set a strong foundation for future success and we will continue to move this program forward with the support from the RPI campus community and our terrific fans in the Capital Region. This is our home and my wife and I are excited about raising our kids here while bringing RPI hockey back to national prominence."

Appert, the 12th head men's hockey coach in the storied program's history, spent nine seasons as an assistant coach at Denver, where he was responsible for recruiting, on-ice coaching, video breakdown and game analysis work. He also played a big role in the development of the Pioneers' goaltenders.

A collegiate netminder at Ferris State University, Appert individually coached one All-America, two All-WCHA honorees, two WCHA Playoff Most Valuable Players and two Frozen Four Most Outstanding Players at Denver.

Three of his goaltenders were draft picks of the NHL, including one Hobey Baker Award finalist. All three of those netminders have played in the NHL in recent years.

Appert, who was born August 9, 1974, helped Denver sign numerous nationally-ranked recruiting classes during his nine-year tenure with the Pioneers. Among those he coached or recruited at Denver were the 2006 Hobey Baker Award winner, eight All-Americans, a WCHA Player of the Year, 22 All-WCHA picks, three WCHA Defensive Players of the Year, two WCHA Student-Athletes of the Year and 17 NHL draft picks. The Pioneers averaged over 23 wins per year during his tenure as an assistant coach and captured two NCAA National Championships, three WCHA playoff championships and two WCHA regular-season titles.

A four-year letterwinner at Ferris State from 1992-96, Appert and his wife, Jill, have two daughters, Addison, who is seven, and Campbell, who was born in June 2007.
