NORTH COUNTRY FOES: Rensselaer hosts St. Lawrence on Friday and Clarkson on Saturday ... Both games begin at 7pm.

SECOND TIME AROUND: This weekend marks the second time the Engineers will have faced the Saints and Golden Knights ... Rensselaer suffered a 2-0 setback at SLU on November 5 and a 4-1 loss in Potsdam the night before.

STUDENTS BACK: This weekend's games mark the first of 2012 with RPI's students back in session ... Spring semester classes began on Monday.

UPCOMING: Rensselaer is right back at home next weekend when it hosts league opponents Cornell and Colgate next Friday and Saturday ... Friday's game with the nationally-ranked Big Red begins at 7:30pm and will be televised nationally on NBC Sports Network ... The tilt with the Raiders is the 35th Annual Big Red Freakout! ... That game starts at 7pm and will air live on Time Warner Cable channel 1 in conjunction with RPI TV.



TICKETS: Tickets to all Rensselaer home games are available through the Houston Field House box office or by calling 518-276-6262.

RENSSELAER TO DATE: Rensselaer, which is 3-1-1 in its last five games, averages 1.58 goals on 26.1 shots per game with 14.7 penalty minutes per contest ... The Engineers allow 2.92 goals and 28.5 shots per game ... The opposition averages 13.2 PIMs.

OFFENSIVE LEADERS: Junior Nick Bailen (team-high 5 goals, 11 assists), a defenseman, is RPI's leading scorer with 16 points ... Sophomore Brock Higgs (1 goal, team-high 14 assists), a forward, is second with 15 ... Junior forward C.J. Lee (3 goals, 6 assists) and freshman forward Ryan Haggerty (team-high 5 goals, 4 assists) are next with nine points apiece ... Senior defenseman Mike Bergin is tops on the team with 46 penalty minutes.

IN GOAL: Junior Bryce Merriam has played 69.2% of the games, including the last two in which he made 81 saves on 82 shots ... On the season he is 5-12-0 with a 2.40 goals against average and a .916 save percentage ... He has two shutouts, both

against Brown ... Freshman **Scott Diebold** has played the other seven games, going 1-5-1 with a 2.85 average and an .899 percentage ... He has one shutout (at RIT).

SPECIAL TEAMS: The Engineers are 14 for 109 (12.8%) on the power play ... RPI is 104 for 122 (85.2%), which is 10th in the nation, when shorthanded ... Rensselaer has one shorthanded goal, that by **Alex Angers-Goulet**.

RPI LAST WEEKEND: RPI posted a pair of wins last weekend, sweeping a road trip to Brown (3-0) and Yale (2-1) ... Junior **Bryce Merriam** stopped 81 of the 82 shots he faced in the two games, including 45 in the win over the Bulldogs, and classmate **Marty O'Grady** scored three goals, including both at Yale ... In Providence the night before, sophomore **Brock Higgs** had three assists and junior defenseman **Nick Bailen** notched a goal and an assist ... Merriam stopped all 36 shots he faced for the shutout.

LAST FIVE GAMES: The Engineers are 3-1-1 in their last five games with their only loss coming at nationally-ranked Union.

TWO STRAIGHT: Last weekend's back-to-back wins were RPI's first since last January 28-29, when they knocked off Brown and Yale at the Houston Field House ... Rensselaer was in the midst of a seven-game unbeaten streak (6-0-1) at that time.

LOW GOALS AGAINST: In their six wins the Engineers have allowed no goals three times and one goal three times.

BLANKING THE BEARS: The Engineers now have 10 shutouts all-time against Brown, which is the most in school history against any one opponent.

ROAD POINTS: The Engineers have made the Brown and Yale road trip on 14 occasions and have come away with at least two points every time ... They earned two points eight times and have collected all four points on the other six trips.

SWEEPS: Prior to last weekend, Rensselaer's most recent sweep at Yale and Brown came in 2006-07 ... The Engineers also took both games in 1990-91, 1989-90, 1988-89 and 1984-85.

TEAM-HIGH: The 46 shots allowed to Yale on Saturday marked the most the Engineers have given up in a game this season.

TIED AFTER ONE: In Rensselaer's six victories, it was tied after the first period of each one.

AFTER TWO PERIODS: Saturday's victory marked the first time RPI earned a win when not leading after two periods ... The Engineers are now 5-0-1 when leading after the second period, 1-4-0 when tied and 0-11-0 when behind.

WHEN OUTSHOT: Friday night's win at Brown was the first time Rensselaer earned a victory when being outshot by its opponent ... It's record is now 1-11-1 in such situations.

SEASON-HIGHS: Junior goaltender **Bryce Merriam** made a season-high 36 saves in Friday's win over Brown ... He then had 45 stops the next night at Yale ... Merriam is the first RPI netminder to reach the 40-save mark since **Allen York '12** did so last February 25 (40 saves) ... For his performances, Merriam was named the ECAC Hockey Goaltender of the Week.

THREE HELPERS: Sophomore **Brock Higgs** had three assists in the win at Brown on Friday ... It marked the first time an Engineers player had three helpers in a game since **Tyler Helfrich '11** at Princeton last February 5.

TWO MARKERS: Junior **Marty O'Grady** had two goals in the win at Yale ... It was the first time an Engineers player scored twice in a game since **Chase Polacek '11** against Colgate last March 5.

BAILEN ON A ROLL: Junior defenseman **Nick Bailen** has 13 points (4 goals, 9 assists) in his last 12 games ... He had his six-game point streak (2 goals, 6 assists) snapped on Saturday.

HIGGS HOT: Sophomore forward **Brock Higgs** has 11 points on a goal and 10 assists

in his last 10 games ... He was held without a point in just two of those contests.

O'GRADY ON: Junior forward **Marty O'Grady** has three goals and four assists for seven points in his last seven games ... He has at least one point in six of those games ... O'Grady was the ECAC Hockey Player of the Week following his three-goal performance last weekend at Brown and Yale.

EIGHT IN NINE: Junior forward **C.J. Lee** has five points (2 goals, 3 assists) in his last five games and a point in eight of his last nine (3 goals, 5 assists).

TWO DOWN: Senior forward **Alex Angers-Goulet** missed last weekend's games, the third and fourth straight he has been sidelined due to a leg injury ... Freshman **Matt Neal** missed last week's action due to illness.

OFFICIALS: The referees for Friday night are Harry Dumas and Tom Steinel, Jr. ... The linesmen are Ryan Knapp and Dan Taggart ... Saturday's officials are Cameron Lynch and Chip McDonald (referees) and Leo Boylan and David Brown (linesmen).

ALL-TIME VS. ST. LAWRENCE: Rensselaer is 51-76-6 all-time against St. Lawrence dating back to the first-ever meeting, a 7-2 Saints win in Troy on January 3, 1951 ... RPI is 43-55-6 in ECAC Hockey games vs. SLU, including a 2-0 loss in Canton in the opening weekend of ECAC Hockey play.

RECENTLY: RPI and St. Lawrence split their two meetings last season with both teams winning 5-3 on the road ... RPI snapped a three-game winless streak (0-2-1) against St. Lawrence with its win in the first matchup last season (Jan. 8) ... Prior to the three-game slide, the Engineers won three straight games against the Saints.

LAST SIX: Rensselaer is 1-4-1 in its last six games against St. Lawrence.

NOVEMBER 5: Sophomore Greg Carey assisted on both goals and St. Lawrence defeated Rensselaer, 2-0 at Appleton Arena ... SLU got the scoring started when Carey sent a centering pass from the left corner that found freshman Patrick Doherty alone in the low slot and he buried a one-timer just under the crossbar ... Junior defenseman George Hughes gave the hosts a 2-0 lead on a slap shot from the left point that made its way through traffic ... Saints' sophomore netminder Matt Weninger stopped all 18 shots he faced, while RPI junior goalie Bryce

ST. LAWRENCE TO DATE: The Saints, who remain without head coach Joe Marsh due to injury, are 0-3-1 in their last four games ... SLU is paced up front by junior Kyle Flanagan, who has 10 goals, including seven on the power play, with 15 assists in 16 games ... Sophomore Greg Carey has 21 points (7 goals, 14 assists) in 24 contests ... Sophomore Matt Weninger has started 21 games with a 7-11-3 record, a 3.04 goals against average and an .899 save percentage.

RPI VS. CLARKSON ALL-TIME: Rensselaer is 44-82-8 all-time against Clarkson dating back to the first-ever meeting, a 14-1 Engineers win in Troy on January 24, 1925 ... RPI is 29-69-7 in 105 ECAC Hockey games against the Golden Knights, including a 4-1 loss in Potsdam in the ECAC Hockey opener for both teams.

RECENTLY: The Engineers split the season series with the Golden Knights last year, losing in overtime at home (3-2 on Jan. 7) and winning on the road (5-1 on Feb. 19) ... The year before, Rensselaer won both games, 5-2 in Potsdam and 2-1 in Troy ... Those victories snapped a four-game losing streak and a six-game winless skid (0-5-1) to Clarkson.

NOVEMBER 4: Senior Corey Tamblyn netted a pair of goals to lead Clarkson to a 4-1 victory ... Rensselaer freshman Ryan Haggerty got the visitors on the scoreboard first, netting his first collegiate goal - a power-play tally at 18:06 of the first period ... The Golden Knights tied it up with just nine seconds left in the opening frame on Tamblyn's first goal of the contest ... Senior Louke Oakley then notched the eventual game-winning tally at 8:43 of the second - the only goal scored in the stanza ... Paul Karpowich earned the victory, making 20 saves, while Bryce Merriam finished with 28 stops.

CLARKSON TO DATE: The Golden Knights, who are 2-0-1 in their last three games, are led offensively by a pair of senior forwards ... Nick Tremblay and Louke Oakley both have 11 goals and 12 assists for 23 points in 24 games ... On the other end, Paul Karpowich, also a senior, has played 91.8% of the games ... He is 11-8-5, including five shutouts, with a 2.10 goals against average and a .931 save percentage, which is seventh in the nation ... Clarkson is coached by first-year head coach Casey Jones.

IN THE RECORD BOOKS: RPI has played Clarkson (134 games) and St. Lawrence (133) more than any other opponent ... Rensselaer's 82 losses to the Golden Knights and 76 to the Saints are also first and second, respectively ... The Engineers have 51 wins over St. Lawrence, which is fifth against any one school.

MOST LEAGUE GAMES, TOO: Rensselaer's 105 and 104 league games against Clarkson and St. Lawrence, respectively, are the most against any school.
