FINAL NON-LEAGUE GAME: Rensselaer hosts American International in the final non-league game of the regular season ... RPI comes into the contest with a 3-16-1 record, while the Yellow Jackets are 3-14-2 ... The Engineers play in ECAC Hockey, while AIC plays in Atlantic Hockey.

NON-LEAGUE BY LEAGUE: The Engineers are 2-9-0 in non-conference contests ... They are 1-3-0 against the WCHA, 0-3-0 versus the CCHA, 1-1-0 against Atlantic Hockey, 0-1-0 versus ECAC Hockey and 0-1-0 against Hockey East ... RPI's final 13 regular season games are against ECAC Hockey foes.

NON-LEAGUE LEADERS: Sophomore **Brock Higgs** has seven points (1 goal, 6 assists) in six non-league games to lead the Engineers ... **Nick Bailen** (2 goals, 2 assists) and freshman **Ryan Haggerty** (2 goals, 2 assists) both have four points against non-conference opposition ... **Bryce Merriam** has played seven games, going 1-6-0 with a 2.76 goals against average and .903 save percentage ... **Scott Diebold** is 1-3-0 with a 2.77 average and an .884 percentage.

UPCOMING: RPI is back on the ice on Saturday when it travels west to take on Union in Schenectady ... Saturday's game begins at 7pm and can be heard live on WRPI, 91.5 FM, and www.wrpi.org.



NO TELEVISION VS. DUTCH: This Saturday's game at Union was originally slated to be aired live on Time Warner Cable Sports ... As it turns out, that matchup will not be televised.

HOME AGAIN: The Engineers return to the Houston Field House on January 27-28 when St. Lawrence and Clarkson come to Troy ... Both games begin at 7pm.

TICKETS: Tickets to all Rensselaer home games are available ... More information is available by calling the box office at 518-276-6262.

RENSSELAER TO DATE: Rensselaer averages 1.45 goals on 24.9 shots per game with 14.8 penalty minutes per contest ... The Engineers allow 3.15 goals and 27.2 shots per game ... The opposition averages 13.8 PIMs.

OFFENSIVE LEADERS: Junior **Nick Bailen** (3 goals, 9 assists), a defenseman, is RPI's leading scorer with 12 points ... Sophomore **Brock Higgs** (1 goal, 10 assists), a forward, is second with 11, followed by freshman forward **Ryan Haggerty** (team-high 5 goals, 4 assists) ... Bailen has played all 20 games, while Higgs and Haggerty have suited up for 15 and 17, respectively.

IN GOAL: Junior **Bryce Merriam** and freshman **Scott Diebold** have been sharing time in net lately, alternating starts over the last eight games ... On the season Merriam is 2-12-0 with a 2.768 goals against average and an .899 save percentage ... **Diebold** is 1-4-1 with a 2.65 average and a .900 percentage ... Merriam and Diebold have one shutout each.

SPECIAL TEAMS: The Engineers are 12 for 91 (13.2%) on the power play ... RPI is 85 for 101 (84.2%) when shorthanded – good enough for 16th in the nation – with one goal for (**Alex Angers-Goulet**).

AIC TO DATE: American International comes into tonight's game having lost four straight games, though it has been idle since December 10 ... The Yellow Jackets were 1-0-2 in its three previous contests, including a 3-0 victory at Brown.

TEAM LEADERS: AIC, which scores 2.00 goals per game, is led in scoring by sophomore forward Jon Puskar, who has 13 points on five goals and eight assists ... Junior Jeff Ceccacci, a former teammate of RPI's **C.J. Lee** in Green Bay, is the team's top scoring defenseman, seventh overall, with six points (2 goals, 4 assists) ... In goal, junior Ben Meisner has played 18 games, posting a 3-11-2 record with a 3.08 goals against average ... He has a .917 save percentage.

AGAINST AIC ALL-TIME: Rensselaer and American International have played 22 games prior to tonight, with RPI earning a 20-1-1 record (.932) ... The two teams played regularly between the 1950s and 1970s ... The series resumed in 2007 and the two teams last played in 2009.

between the Engineers and Yellow Jackets, 20 have been played in Troy ... RPI is 18-1-1 in those matchups.

SHUTOUTS: Rensselaer has five shutouts against AIC in the series history, the most recent coming in 1972 (19-0).

LONE LOSS: The Engineers have suffered one loss to the Yellow Jackets, a 6-1 defeat on February 5, 1966 ... That game was played in Troy.

FORMER LEAGUE FOE: American International was once a league foe of the Engineers, with RPI posting a 3-0-0 mark against the Yellow Jackets as members of the then-ECAC.

RECENTLY: Rensselaer has played AIC twice since the 2007-08 season ... The two teams tied, 1-1, in the 2007 RPI Invite (the Engineers advanced with a 2-1 victory in a 5-round shootout) ... In the most recent game, October 24, 2009, RPI posted a 3-2 win.

OCTOBER 24, 2009: The freshman line of **Jerry D'Amigo** (1 goal, 2 assists), **Brandon Pirri** (2 assists) and **Marty O'Grady** (1 goal) combined for six points to lead RPI to a 3-2 win over AIC ... D'Amigo broke a 2-2 tie at 17:46 of the third period for the victory ... Adam Pleskach had both goals for American International, which battled back from a 2-0 deficit ... **Bryce Merriam** made 18 saves for his first career win, while Ben Meisner stopped 34 shots for the Yellow Jackets.

OFFICIALS: The referees for tonight's game are Alex Dell and Peter Feola ... The linesmen are and Matt Brady and Michael Emanatian.

FIRST NHL POINT: Former Engineers standout **Brandon Pirri** registered the first point of his NHL career in the Chicago Blackhawks' season opening loss to Dallas

... Pirri had the secondary assist on a goal by Nick Leddy ... The game was the second in the NHL for Pirri, who played one season at RPI, totaling 43 points on 11 goals and 32 assists in 39 games in 2009-10 ... He has since played two more games with the Blackhawks, tallying another assist.

FIRST NHL GAME: Former Rensselaer netminder **Allen York** made his NHL debut with the Columbus Blue Jackets against Detroit on October 25 ... He made his first NHL start at Chicago on October 29 ... To date he has appeared in four games with the Blue Jackets this season, going 0-1-0 with a 3.53 goals against average and .878 save percentage ... He finished his career at RPI with a record of 37-33-8, 2.47 GAA, .915 save percentage and four shutouts in 83 career games ... He ranks first all-time in GAA and is fourth in percentage ... He was a two-time finalist for the Ken Dryden Award, given to the ECAC Goaltender of the Year.

TWENTY-SECOND NHLER: With **Allen York** making his NHL debut earlier this season, he became the 22nd former Engineer to skate in the National Hockey League ... The others are **John Carter**, **Don Cutts**, **Marty Dallman**, **Mike Dark**, **Tim Friday**, **Ken Hammond**, **Eric Healey**, **Joe Juneau**, **Larry Landon**, **Neil Little**, **Mike McPhee**, **Matt Murley**, **Kraig Nienhuis**, **Adam Oates**, **Brandon Pirri**, **Brian Pothier**, **Daren Puppa**, **George Servinis**, **Steve Stoyanovich**, **Brad Tapper** and **Graeme Townshend**.

ALL-TIME NHL LEADERS: **Adam Oates** is the former Engineer with the most NHL games (1337), goals (341), assists (1079) and points (1420) ... **Mike McPhee** has the most NHL penalty minutes (661) and **Daren Puppa** has the most victories (179).

ONE NHL COACH: Former Rensselaer netminder **Kevin Constantine** has been the head coach of three different National Hockey League teams: San Jose, Pittsburgh and New Jersey.

BROTHERHOOD: Rensselaer forwards **Alex Angers-Goulet** and **Greg Burgdoerfer** both had brothers who played for the Engineers ... Alex's older brother, **Matt**, played for RPI from 2005-09, serving as the team's captain as a senior ... **Erik Burgdoerfer**, Greg's identical twin, was a defenseman for RPI from 2006-10 ... He is currently playing for Bakersfield in the ECHL ... **Matt Angers-Goulet**, a former forward, is currently attending medical school.
